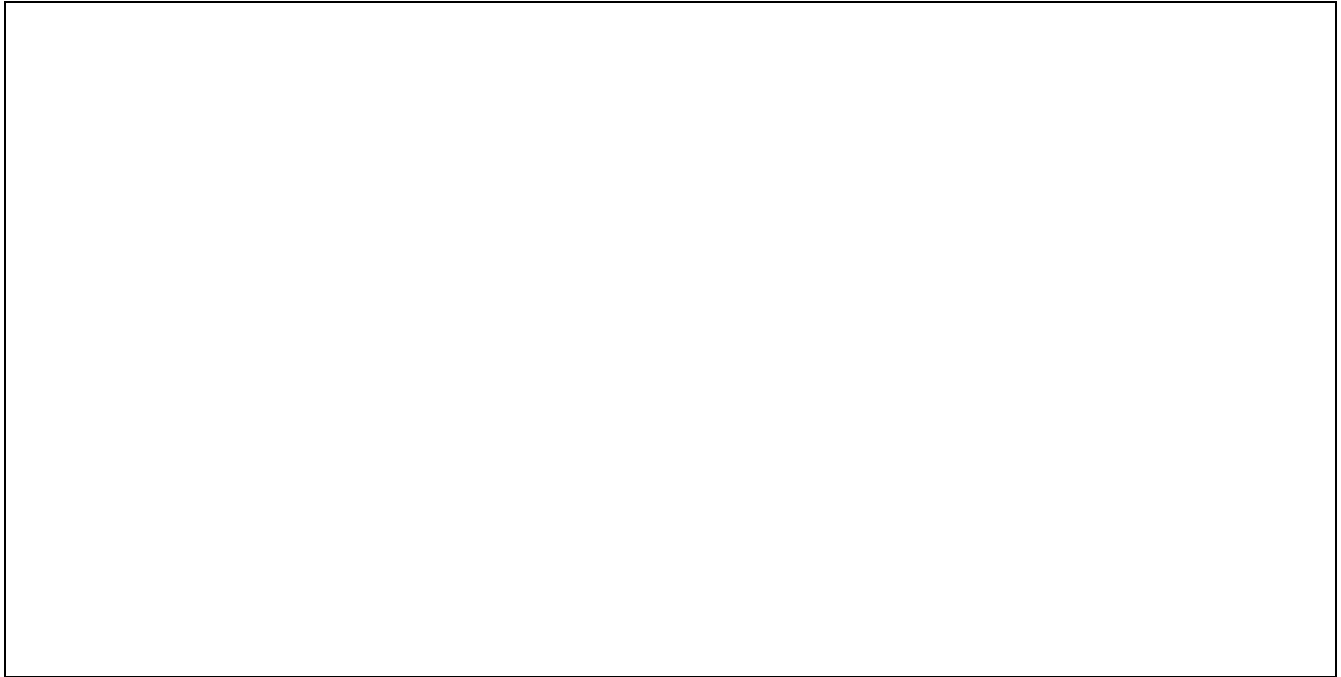


Buzz Sells Milk
















Ross and his mom went to the mall. Ross got golf clubs and golf balls. The golf balls are small. The man from the mall said Ross can hit the balls in the hall.

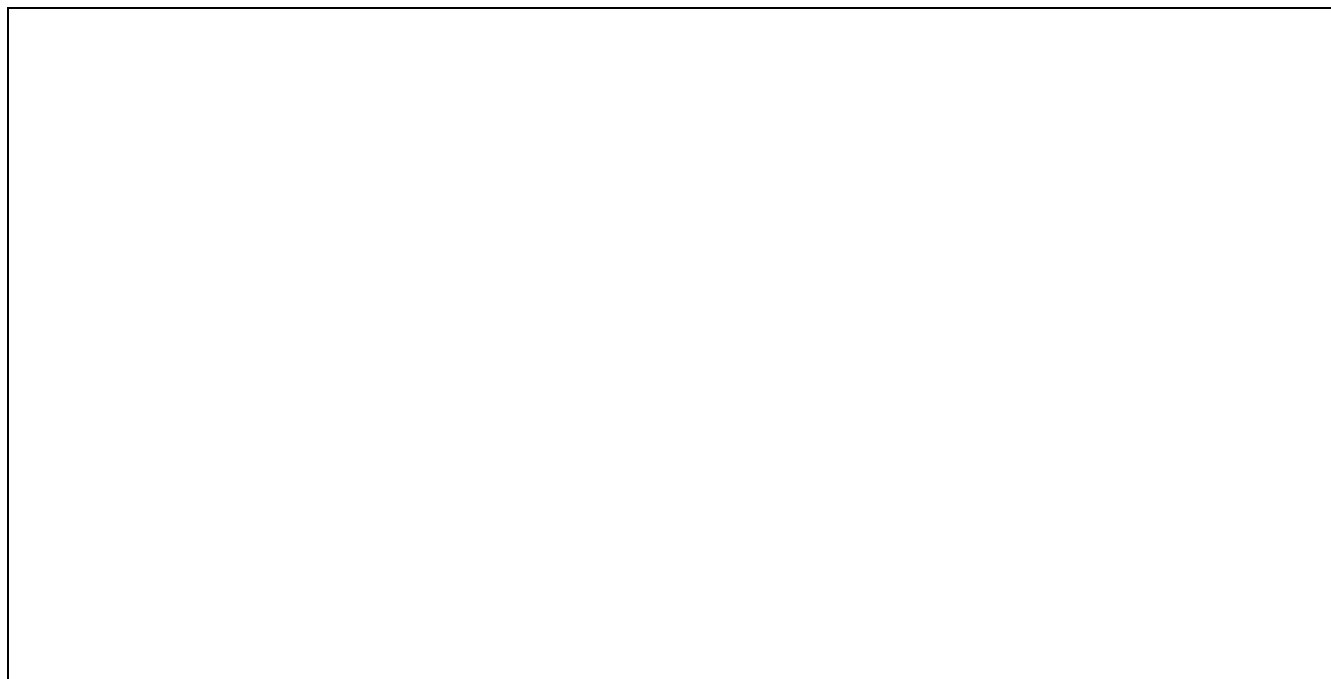

The Mud Track










The pals run back to the track. A truck ran into a stack of bricks! The pack yells and jumps. “The mud track is the best,” says Mack.








The Ship









Look at the ship. Trish and Josh jump on the ship deck. Trish has a net to get fish. Josh has a bag to get shells.

Trish jumps off the ship with the net. She swims to get fish. Josh jumps off the ship with his bag. He swims to get shells.

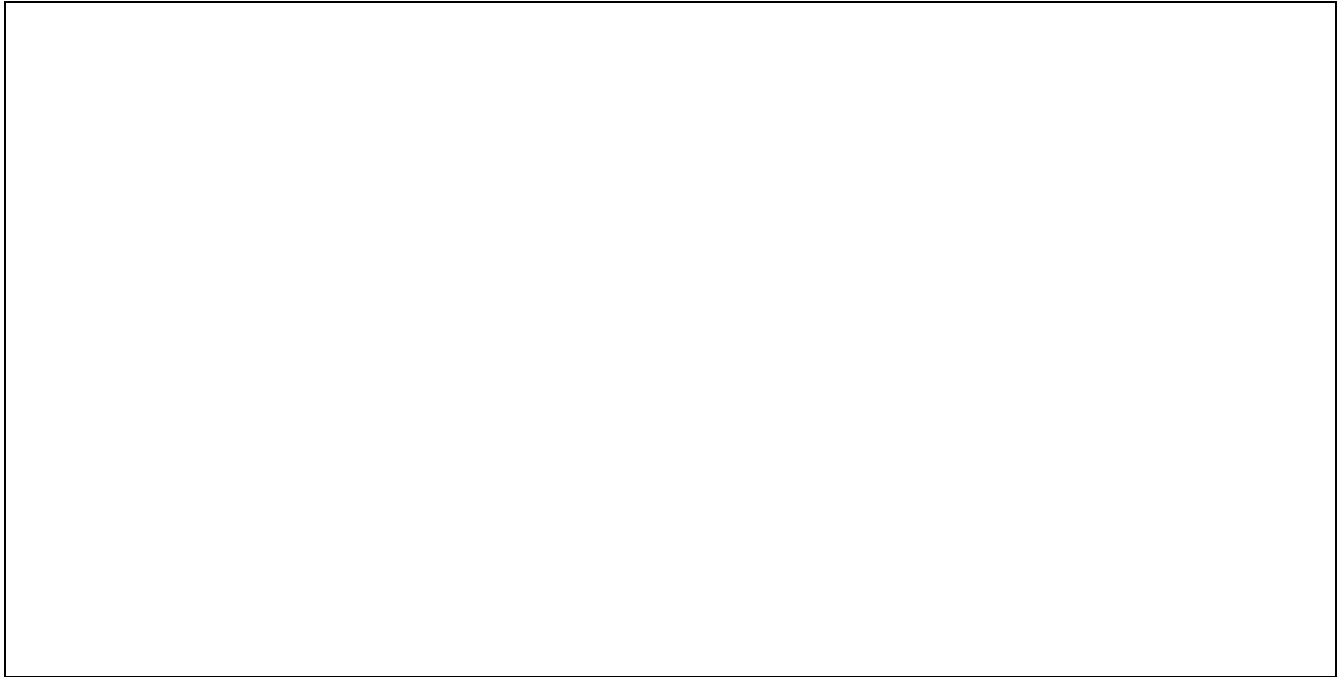
Trish and Josh get back on the ship. “Look at the fish in my net,” said Trish. “Look at the shells in my bag,” said Josh. We had fun on the ship.









Jack and Finn want to go to the pond. Finn picks this red hat. Jack picks that pink hat. Finn picks this big backpack. Jack picks that small backpack.

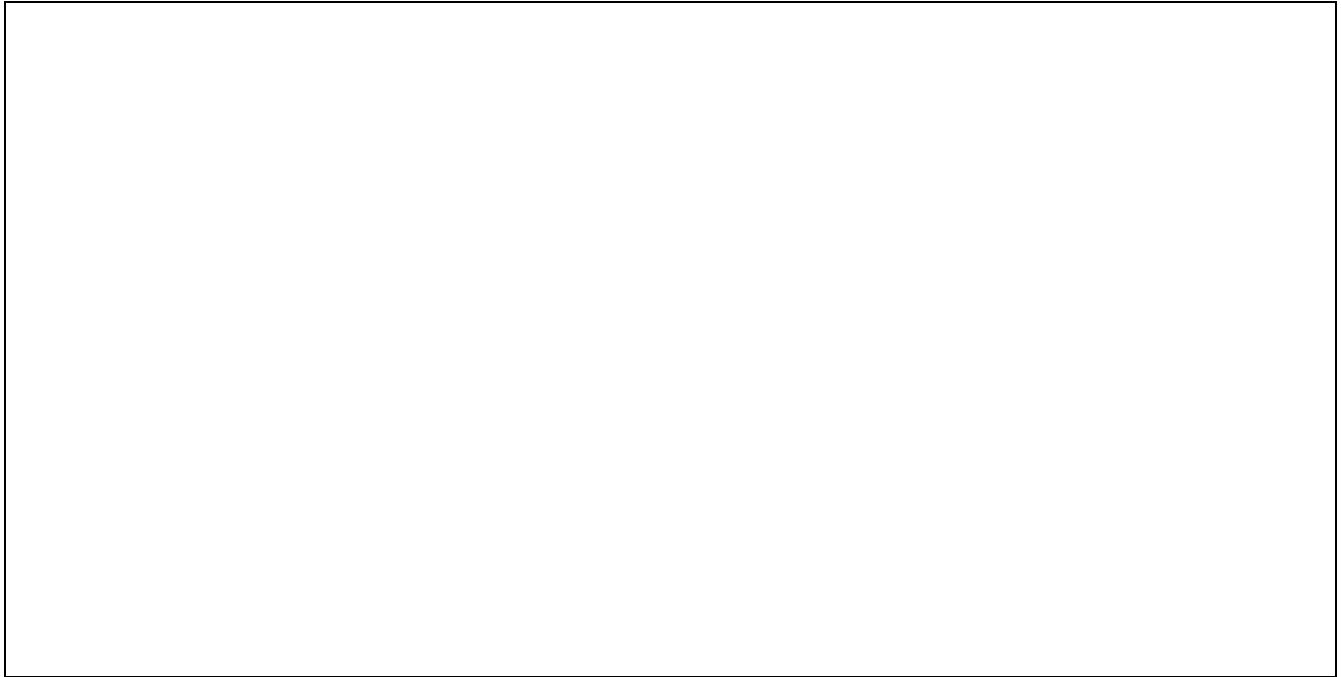







Thad and Cath go on a jog at camp. They have six paths to pick from. They pick the fifth path.

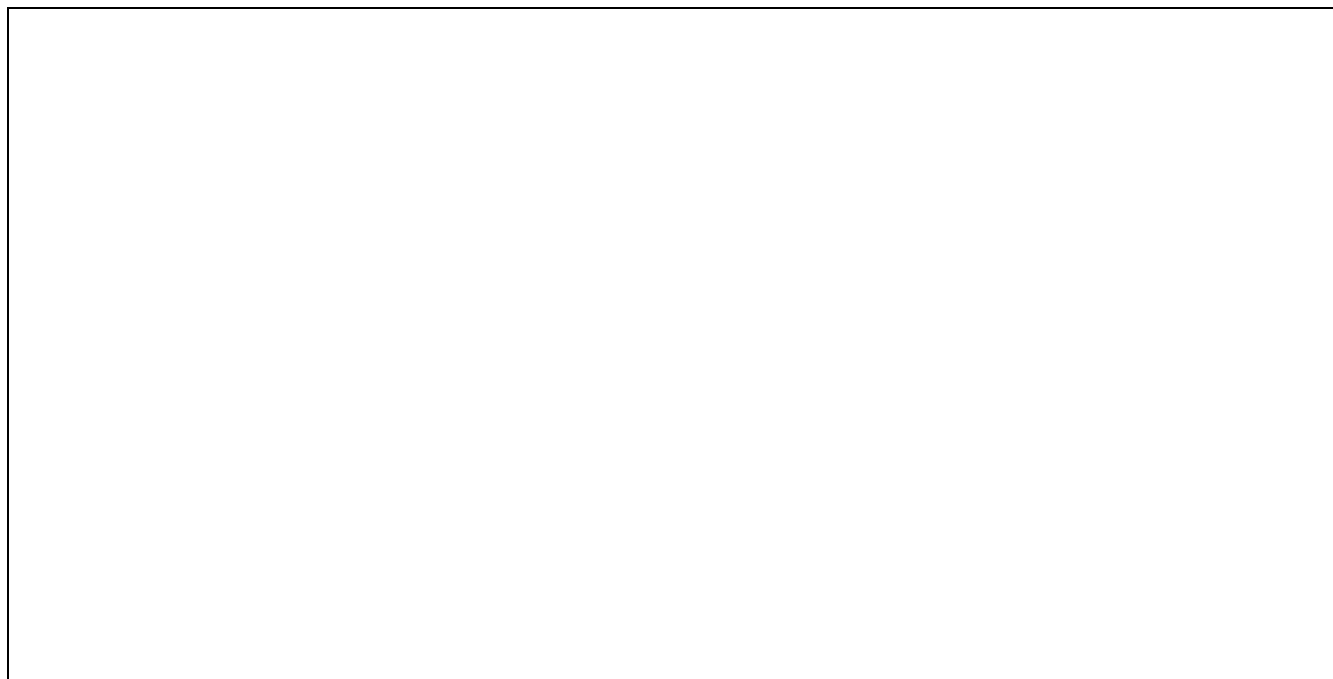
Thad and Cath jog back to camp. At camp they grab a wet cloth to wash off. “That was a fun jog,” said Thad.

Snacks for the Pets









Beth has a lot of pets. She has ten small chicks and six big sloths. She grabs a big bag of snacks and drags it to the pet pens.

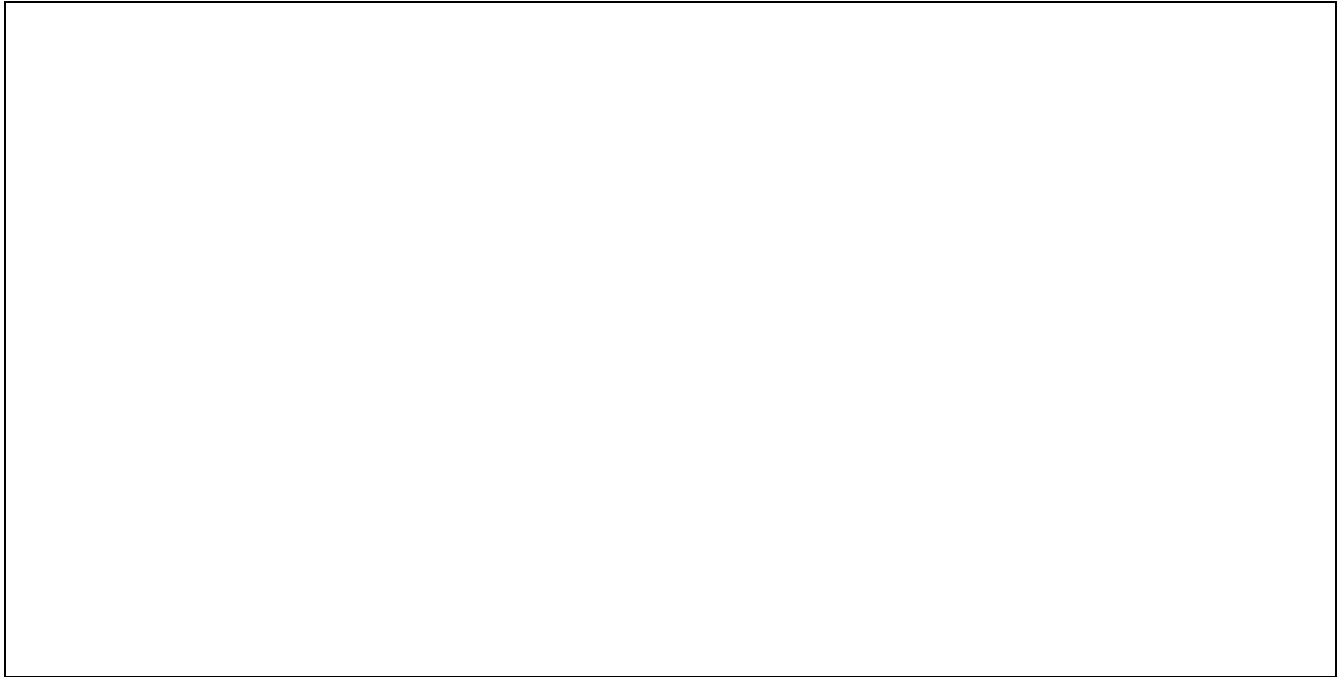
Beth grabs the last snack in the bag. “I will have this snack,” Beth says. Beth sits on the grass and snacks with the pets.







Phil and Whit went on a walk. On a whim, they went to see Steph. She could whip them up a snack. She was a whiz with a whisk.

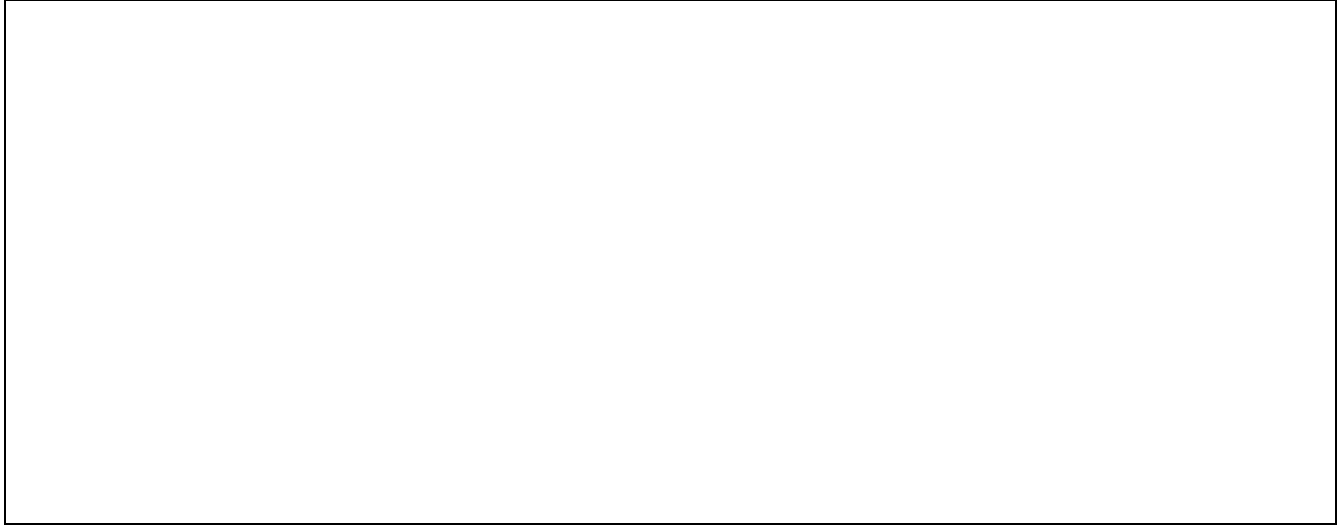
Phil and Whit got a whiff of the dish. “Yum!” said Whit. The pals were glad they went to see Steph on a whim!

Stink in the Bank








The Ship Dock









